

EHSC Year End Awards Description and Points Calculation Guidelines

Approved - April 2, 2024

Points for year-end awards are earned as follows:

Placing	Points
1 st	7
2 nd	5
3 rd	4
4 th	3
5 th	2
6 th	1

Classes with up to 10 entries will receive single points; 11 to 20 entries shall receive double points; and 21 or more entries shall receive triple points.

Points for Champion and Reserve for all divisions at the EHSC Hunter/Jumper Summer Series shows are to be calculated as follows:

Placing	1	2	3	4	5	6
Points	10	6	4	2	1	.5

EHSC Year End Award Rules:

1. No horse or pony may accumulate points at any event unless the completed registration form has been received by the Year-End Points Coordinator prior to entering the ring in a class for which the horse/pony and rider may collect points.
2. A horse/pony may have different riders during the year. Only points collected while horse/pony is registered with the Erie Hunt & Saddle Club count towards year-end awards. If both riders have registered the animal, then points collected under each rider will be counted. Horse/pony and rider combinations must remain the same for points to count.
3. Points may be collected at all competitions sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year.
4. The name of the registered horse/pony must remain the same for the entire show season. The name must be used when registering for classes and shows. Failure to use the same name for the entire show season will result in a loss of points.

5. Rider's age is determined as of December 1 of the previous year. Horse's age is determined as of January 1 of this year.
6. Junior members are those who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1 of the previous year.
7. Adult members are those who have reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1 of the previous year.
8. Points are calculated to 6th place. See chart on previous page.
9. Every point count towards Horse/Pony of the Year Award, except equitation, medal, horsemanship, lead line, walk trot, Jockey Club T.I.P. and any breed/type classes, unless otherwise noted.
10. Any type of class that is walk-trot only, only counts towards the Walk Trot Award.
11. For Combined Tests and Mini Trials, the dressage score counts towards the dressage award and the overall score counts towards Horse/Pony of the Year, Combined Test, and Jumping Award.
12. Any points earned in a halter, grooming and showmanship, trail or driving class will only count, when applicable, towards the Horse or Pony of the Year award and the Miniature Horse, Draft and OTTB Thoroughbred awards.
13. Points earned in any miniature-horse class only counts towards the Miniature Horse Award.
14. Points earned in any draft type class only apply towards the Draft Horse Award.
15. Points earned in Jockey Club T.I.P. and any other OTTB classes only count towards the OTTB Thoroughbred Award. The T.I.P. number must be included on entry form.
16. No points will be awarded for Lead Line or any winner-takes-all type fun classes, such as Egg and Spoon, Dollar Race and Cake Walks.
17. Any point disputes must be brought to the attention of the point's coordinator within 2 weeks of points posting on the website.

EHSC Year End Awards:

President's Award: Awarded annually by the president to one or more members who has demonstrated a dedication to the club above and beyond the volunteer requirements.

Hull Cup: Awarded annually to a club member each year for outstanding service to the club.

Horse of the Year: Champion and Reserve awarded to the horse accumulating the most points from any or all performance classes (excluding Lead Line, Walk Trot, equitation/medal/horsemanship, and any breed/type specific classes) of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club.

Pony of the Year: Champion and Reserve awarded to the pony accumulating the most points from any or all performance classes (excluding Lead Line, Walk Trot, equitation/medal/horsemanship, and any breed/type specific classes) of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club.

Walk Trot: Champion and Reserve awarded to the rider and horse/pony combination accumulating the most points in any walk trot classes of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year.

Junior Hunter: Champion and Reserve awarded to the junior rider and horse/pony combination accumulating the most points in any or all hunter classes (excluding equitation/medal and any breed/type specific classes) whether in hand, on the flat, or over fences of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year.

Adult Hunter: Champion and Reserve awarded to the adult rider and horse/pony combination accumulating the most points in any or all hunter classes (excluding equitation/medal and any breed/type specific classes) whether in hand, on the flat, or over fences of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year.

Junior Jumping: Champion and Reserve awarded to the junior rider and horse/pony combination accumulating the most points in any or all jumper classes of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year. For Combined Tests, the overall placing counts towards the Junior Jumping Award.

Adult Jumping: Champion and Reserve awarded to the adult rider and horse/pony combination accumulating the most points in any or all jumper classes of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year. For Combined Tests, the overall placing counts towards the Adult Jumping Award.

Junior Hunt Seat Equitation: Champion and Reserve awarded to the junior rider accumulating the most points in any or all hunt seat equitation and medal classes whether on the flat or over fences of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year.

Adult Hunt Seat Equitation: Champion and Reserve awarded to the adult rider accumulating the most points in any or all hunt seat equitation and medal classes whether on the flat or over fences of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year.

English Pleasure: Champion and Reserve awarded to the horse or pony accumulating the most points from all pleasure classes in which the horse is shown under English tack at the open shows or the hunter/jumper shows of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year.

Western Pleasure: Champion and Reserve awarded to the horse or pony accumulating the most points from all pleasure classes in which the horse or pony is shown under western tack at the open shows of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year.

Western Horsemanship: Champion and Reserve awarded to the rider accumulating the most points in any or all Western Horsemanship classes of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year.

Junior Dressage: Champion and Reserve awards to the junior rider and horse/pony combination accumulating the most points in dressage classes at any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year. A minimum of 2 scores over 60% ridden in front of two different judges must be submitted. The average high score of the submitted scores will be used to determine the placing. Combined Test dressage scores are eligible for this award and will be converted to dressage scoring. Placings will be used for Horse/Pony of the Year Award point tabulations.

Adult Dressage: Champion and Reserve awards to the adult rider and horse/pony combination accumulating the most points in dressage classes at any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year. A minimum of 2 scores over 60% ridden in front of two different judges must be submitted. The average high score of the submitted scores will be used to determine the placing. Combined Test dressage scores are eligible for this award and will be converted to dressage scoring. Placings will be used for Horse/Pony of the Year Awards point tabulations.

Junior Combined Training: Champion and Reserve awarded to the junior rider and horse/pony combination accumulating the lowest combined points from the combined tests sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club.

Senior Combined Training: Champion and Reserve awarded to the adult rider and horse/pony combination accumulating the lowest combined points from the combined tests sponsored Erie Hunt & Saddle Club.

Game Horse or Pony: Champion and reserve awards to the horse or pony accumulating the most points from any and all gaming classes (excluding walk-trot games) at competitions sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year.

OTTB Thoroughbred Award: Champion and Reserve awarded to the off-the-track thoroughbred shown in our Jockey Club T.I.P. Hunter division or any other OTTB specific classes accumulating the most points from any or all performance classes (excluding equitation/medal) of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year. The T.I.P. number must be included on entry form.

Miniature Horse: Champion and Reserve awards to the mini horse accumulating the most points from any or all performance classes (excluding equitation/medal) of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year.

Draft Horse: Champion and reserve awards to the draft horse accumulating the most points from any or all performance classes (excluding equitation) of any competition sponsored by Erie Hunt & Saddle Club within the calendar year.
