

EHSC COVID 19 Horse Show Stay Safe Protocol

- * Show staff and volunteers will wear masks and/or face shields within the secretary's stand. Plexiglass will be installed where necessary.
- * Pre-entries are strongly recommended.
- * Only one person will be permitted in the show office at a time, with limited face-to-face contact through plexiglass.
- * One non-equine professional or spectator per exhibitor is permitted to attend the event.
- * There will be no gathering of spectators. Everyone must follow social distancing guidelines.
- * Each exhibitor and their (1) guest should limit their presence at the horse show to their schooling and showing time. Loitering is not recommended or permitted. This includes stabling areas.
- * EHSC encourages everyone attending the horse show to wear a mask and/or shield. Bring your own hand sanitizer.
- * Signs will be posted to remind everyone about social distancing of a minimum of 6 feet.
- * In the event of a storm you will be asked to shelter in your car.
- * No congregating at any time anywhere on the grounds.
- * Show stabling will be separated by farm.
- * Trainers will be held responsible for their barns, ensuring compliance with all rules and regulations.
- * Before heading to any EHSC competition, conduct a daily symptom assessment (self-evaluation). Anyone experiencing symptoms including cough, shortness of breath, fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headaches, sore throat, and new loss of taste or smell should stay home.
- * If you have been exposed to anyone with COVID-19, stay home for the recommended quarantine.
- * Any individual not in compliance with these regulations will be asked to leave the grounds and not return.
- * A signed waiver and release form is required by all show staff, volunteers, attendees, including competitors, trainers, judges, and spectators.
