DRESSAGE SHOW GENERAL RULES

Shows will be run under USDF/USEA/USEF Rules where applicable.

- Entries will not be accepted without full payment of the fees and signatures. Post entries will be accepted if scheduling
 permits, at twice the stated fee with full payment of fees and signatures. No refunds after the closing date. No class
 changes will be made after the schedule is complete.
- 2. Schedule and ride times will be posted on the website (www.eriehuntandsaddleclub.org) the day before the show and on the club's Facebook page.
- 3. All USDF Introductory and USEA tests will be ridden in the small arena. USEF First Level and up will be ridden in the standard arena. Training level will be at the discretion of management.
- 4. The most current USDF, USEA, USEF, WDAA, and WE tests will be used.
- 5. Test may be called by a reader provided by the rider.
- Competitor's responsibility to check in with the paddock master prior to their ride time.
- Competitors have 45 seconds to enter the Dressage Ring after the signal (Bell/Whistle/Car Horn). Failure to do so will result in elimination.
- 8. The Show Committee/Organizer reserves the right to limit entries, limit the classes per horse, to provide additional judges, to add, divide or cancel classes, or make necessary changes that are required due to circumstances of the competition.
- 9. All divisions will be divided by Junior/Senior/Professional when possible.
- 10. Neither the Erie Hunt and Saddle Club nor the Show Committee/Organizer will be responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, horses or property of exhibitors or spectators.
- 11. Placings based on percentage, not on score.
- 12. Awards to 6th place per class (minimum of three entries per class required).
- 13. Coggins tests recommended for PA horses. Coggins tests are required for out-of-state horses.

Rules for Attire and Equipment

Informal Attire: Breeches, boots or half chaps. **ASTM-SEI** helmet is required. Coat and stock are optional. Braiding is not required. Safety vest allowed. Boots, wraps, martingales, seat savers, and side reins are prohibited and will result in elimination.

Equipment: English type saddles for USEF, USDF, USEA, Prix Caprilli, and Western type saddles for WDAA and WDE are permitted. Proper length whips (47.2") and spurs (1.57") are allowed. Only bits approved for Dressage are permitted (check proper website depending on test for their approved bits).

Dressage Show General Rules Revised 4/13/2025

PRIX DE VILLES DRESSAGE TEAM COMPETITION RULES

Shows will be run under USDF/USEA/USEF Rules where applicable.

1. Team entry fee is \$25 per rider, in addition to class entry fees. The team competition is open to all riders. Only one professional rider per team allowed. Teams consist of 3 or 4 horse/rider combinations. Horse/Rider combinations team entries may not have competed more than one level above their team rides. Horses may only show on one team, riders may show on up to 2 teams on different horses. All team members must ride BOTH TEAM TESTS at their chosen level. A maximum of 2 riders may ride the same level on a team. The combined scores for the day will be the final team score. Highest team score wins. The top 6 scores will be tabulated to determine the total team score. If there are 4 riders, the lowest 2 scores will be dropped. If there are only 3 riders on a team, then all of the scores will count. In the case of ties, the highest single score of a non-professional on the team will decide. No substitution of horse or rider after the first team test is ridden. USEF test teams and USEA test teams will be separate divisions. See below for the eligible tests for each team division.

a. Low Division: USEF: Eligible tests - Intro A-C, Training 1-3

b. Low Division USEA: Eligible tests - Intro A, B; Beginner Novice A, B

c. High Division USEF: Eligible tests - Training 1-3, First Level and above

d. High Division USEA: Eligible tests - Novice A, B, above

- 2. Awards Presentation: A formal awards ceremony will be held following the completion of the last class on Sunday. The top 3 teams in each division are required to participate on foot for a podium ceremony. Victory gallop may be completed at Management's discretion.
- Team Prix de Ville Prize Money: 50 % of team entry fees per division to be divided as prize money. Prize money will be divided equally among riders on the team completing both team rides.

a. First Place Team 50 %

b. Second Place Team 30 %

c. Third Place Team 20 %

d. Fourth-Sixth Place Teams Ribbons
