## COMBINED TEST GENERAL RULES

Shows will be run under USEA /USEF Rules where applicable.

1. Entries will not be accepted without full payment of the fees and signatures. Post entries will be accepted, if scheduling permits, at the stated fee with full payment of fees and signatures. No refunds after the closing date.
2. Schedule and ride times will be posted on the website ([www.eriehuntandsaddleclub.org](http://www.eriehuntandsaddleclub.org)) the day before the show and on our Facebook page.
3. Combined Test divisions are limited to two divisions per horse and two horses per rider. Divisions will run Intro to Training.
4. All the Dressage tests are to be ridden in the small ring. Competitors are to check in with the paddock master prior to their ride time.
5. Competitor has 45 seconds to enter the Dressage Ring after the signal (whistle/car horn). Failure to do so will result in elimination.
6. Tests may be called by a reader provided by the rider.
7. **Dressage Inquiries:** Upon completion of each Dressage Division, the announcer will make an announcement that the tests are available from the secretary and the official time that the tests will be posted.
8. **Inquire Procedure: Time Period:** 30 minutes from the time the scores are posted. Inquiries shall be made to the show secretary and will decide on inquiry merit.
9. Stadium Course will be open for walking 30 minutes prior to the start of each division (unless the only course change is height). Stadium shall be timed. Ground Pole, Intro and Starter times are used only for tie breakers. Competitor has 45 seconds to enter the ring after the signal (whistle/car horn). Failure to do so will result in elimination. See attached "Show Jumping Scoring" for faults/penalties.
10. The Show Committee/Organizer reserves the right to limit entries, divide or cancel divisions, or make necessary changes due to circumstances of the competition.
11. All divisions will be divided by Junior/Senior/Professional when possible.
12. Neither the Erie Hunt and Saddle Club nor the Show Committee/Organizer will be responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, horses or property of exhibitors or spectators.
13. Awards to 8th place per division.

### Rules for Attire and Equipment

**Dressage:** Breeches and tall boots, jodhpurs and paddock boots, or breeches and paddock boots with half-chaps are acceptable. Shirts (long or short sleeved) tucked in belt loops, sweaters, vests and/or coats appropriate for the weather. **ASTM-SEI helmet** is required. Safety vest allowed. Snaffle bits as allowed by USEF. Kimberwick or Pelham with converters allowed in walk/trot tests. Breast plates allowed but **NO** martingales permitted. Any English type of saddle permitted. No boots, leg wraps, or seat-savers allowed.

Proper length whips (47.2 inches) and spurs permitted (1.57").

**Stadium:** See above attire. **ASTM/SEI helmet** with chin strap required. Safety vests are highly recommended. Short whips/crops or bats permitted as are allowable spurs. Only Running Martingales (with rein stops) permitted with any English type of saddle. Any bit or bitless bridle allowed. Bell boots, leg wraps or boots allowed. No unauthorized assistance (instructing the rider) allowed. Course to be ridden from memory.
