Open to all horses, ponies and riders. Horses and ponies to show at their respective jump height. To be eligible, the horse or pony must have shown in at least one hunter section at this show before this class. To be shown in a hunt and go format.

Hunt and Go Derby is a single-round class the combines the classic phase (5-7 jumps) and handy phase (5-7 jumps) without a break. Each phase will have 3-4 high options. Each high option will be given 1 extra point to the score, max of 4 bonus points.

Classic phase to be judged on hunter style, quality movement and brilliance; handy phase to be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness.





